This position involves working in Trauma Service in the Mental Health Care Program, and reports to both the Coordinator, General Adult Outpatient Mental Health Services and for professional practice issues to the Manager, Psychology and Social Work. In this position, the Psychologist provides assessment and treatment services as part of an interprofessional team to patients from the Workplace Safety and Insurance Board (WSIB).
