Cancer Care Clinic Services is located on Level 2 of the London Regional Cancer Program at the Victoria Hospital Site of LHSC. The clinic has four outpatient clinics where patients are seen in consultation related to their cancer diagnosis and are assessed for treatment and follow-up care.

Oncology Nurses are a core component of patient care in the clinics. Nurses provide assessments, patient teaching, telephone consultations, and offer support and guidance to both patients and their families. Exceptional communication and time management skills allow them to adapt to a continuously changing and challenging environment.
