The trainer will help OR teams meet surgical demands, while achieving clinical proficiency in the safest, most efficient manner possible by delivering product training, clinical training, and clinical education for integrated teams of both surgeons and OR staff. The successful candidate must be able to travel for training. The training will involve approximately 6, week-long training sessions in California.

- Successful completion of da Vinci ® training offered by Intuitive Surgical® preferred or ability to complete full training within 3 months of employment
- Minimum three years previous related job experience
