## **Registered Nurse – Regular Part-Time “B” Medicine D**

Medicine D provides care to an elderly acute population which are patients over 75 years of age. These patients may experience the presence of geriatric syndrome and acute illness, not requiring bedside cardiac monitoring. Total patient care is provided to this patient population with a focus on patient/family centered care. There are a total of 24 beds, broken down as two (2) 12 beds units.

- Ability to function autonomously and to adapt to constantly changing unpredictable situations, and varying workload
