



Riverforks Community Update – August 2016

Dear Riverforks Community Member:

I am writing today to share news of a temporary program move into 54 Riverview Ave. which will take place effective August 29, 2016. As you may be aware, the former South Street Hospital Annex will be decommissioned in the coming months, meaning all LHSC programs remaining in the facility must now relocate. As a result, some staff training which is conducted through Occupational Health and Safety will be moved, for an undetermined length of time, to 54 Riverview Ave. This staff training is conducted Monday–Friday from 8:00am – 4:00pm. Those attending classes will park in the lot adjacent to the building. We do not anticipate any disruption to the community as a result of this move.

Also, we have been advised by the City of London that they will be moving forward with plans to place a two hour limit on street parking Monday–Friday, 8:00am–6:00pm in an effort to ease congestion in the neighbourhood. We will, as always, continue to encourage our patients and staff to make use of the parking facilities available at 54 Riverview to support this outcome as well.
