DESIPRAMINE, SERUM/ PLASMA



Turnaround Time: 7 days

Alternate Name(s):

Norpramine Pertofone

Specimen:

6 mL Red top Vacutainer tube

Lavender or Pink (EDTA) top tubes are also acceptable

Avoid blood collection tubes with separator gels (e.g., Gold top). Light Green (Li-Heparin) top tubes are also NOT acceptable.



Laboratory: Core Lab



Requisition:GENERAL LABORATORY

Method of Analysis: LC-MS/MS

REQUISITION

Collection Information:

Minimum volume required is 3 mL.

To monitor therapy, draw trough level specimen prior to morning dose or 10 - 12 hours after last drug administration.



Test Schedule: Referred out Monday-Thursday Separate and freeze as soon as possible.

Desipramine is also the metabolite of Imipramine, and is measured routinely when Imipramine is prescribed.
