Reference Ranges:

300-900 mosm/kg

Interpretive Comments:

Useful to assess the concentrating and diluting ability of the kidney.

Comparing serum and urine osmolalities may help to determine the cause of polyuria, to diagnose SIADH and to distinguish 'pre-renal' from 'renal' causes of impaired renal function.
