Collection Information:

Collect blood aseptically in a Vacutainer tube.

Unspun samples need be sent to lab under 4 hours.

Reference Ranges:

Age	Range
0-3 months:	4.00-6.50 mmol/L
>3 months:	3.50-5.00 mmol/L

0-3 months:	>6.5 mmol/L	
>3 months:	<3.0 or >6.0 mmol/L	

Interpretive Comments:

Useful for monitoring potassium status in patients on intravenous therapy, in diabetic ketoacidosis or on diuretics. Investigation of mineralocortocoid status, evaluation of electrolyte balance, acid-base disturbances, cardiac arrhythmia, muscular weakness, hepatic encephalopathy, GIT fluid losses and renal failure.

Method of Analysis: Potentiometric, Indirect Ion-Selective Electrodes



Test Schedule: As required



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Comments:

Hemolysis during collection, delay in separation, refrigeration of unseparated blood, marked luecocytosis and/or thrombocytosis and muscle activity of limb immediately prior to venipuncture may cause significant increase in potassium.
