DESCRIPTION of PRODUCT

- Freeze-dried sterile human plasma fraction with Factor VIII inhibitor bypassing activity.
- Contains Factors II, IX, X, mainly non-activated and Factor VII mainly in the activated form.
- Prepared from human plasma and vapor heated for an in-process virus inactivation.
- Product is supplied as a freeze-dried powder. Also included in the package is sterile water for reconstitution, a sterile double-ended needle, and a filter needle.

AVAILABILITY of PRODUCT

- London CBS stocks this product
- FEIBA is not stocked in the BTL at LHSC / SJHC sites since rFVIIa (Niasase) is the product of choice.

STORAGE of PRODUCT

- Stored at 2 - 8°C. Do NOT freeze.
- Do NOT refrigerate after reconstitution.
- Infusion of FEIBA must be completed within 3 hours of reconstitution.

CLINICAL INDICATIONS (see package insert for contraindications)

- Recombinant Factor VIIa (Niasase), not FEIBA, is product of choice.
- To control spontaneous bleeding events or prior to invasive procedures in Hemophilia A and B patients with inhibitors.
- Cases have been described where FEIBA was used in the treatment of non-hemophiliacs with acquired inhibitors to Factors VIII, XI and XII, as well as in the treatment of a von Willebrand's patient with an inhibitor. (See package insert for details).

REQUESTS for FEIBA

- Requests for FEIBA must be approved by a hematologist.
- Does NOT require Special Access Program (SAP) approval.

ADMINISTRATION of PRODUCT

- Supplied by the BTL in original package or reconstituted and sent in bag for IV administration.
- Coagulation factor concentrate is addressed in the [Bleeding Disorders Program](#) manual, "[Nursing Guidelines for the treatment of hemophilia and other inherited Bleeding Disorders](#)".
