Collection Information:

Minimum volume of serum or plasma required is 360 μ L for adult samples or 150 μ L for pediatric samples.

2-10 years: 3 mL Red top

also acceptable

0-2 years: 0.5 mL Red or Gold top

0.90-2.00 g/L

Interpretive Comments:

Patients with homozygous deficiency of alpha 1-antitrypsin usually have levels less than 0.6 g/L.

Levels rise in acute phase reaction.

Storage and Shipment:

Store and ship serum or plasma refrigerated. Frozen serum or plasma is also acceptable.
