# **Specimen Requirements**

Sample Types: Plasma, Serum

#### **Containers:**

- Adult: 4.5 mL Green (Lithium Heparin) Top Vacutainer
- Pediatric:
  - o 0-2 years: 0.5mL Green Top Microtainer
  - o 2-10 years: 2mL Green Top Vacutainer
- Alternate: Serum from a 5mL Gold Top or 6mL Red Top Vacutainer

Minimum Testing Volume: 0.2mL for pediatric samples

Rejection Criteria: Underfilled tube

#### **Interpretive Comments**

Very sensitive but non-specific indicator of hepatocellular damage. Also elevated in cardiac and skeletal muscle damage and erythrocyte disorders. Hemolysis will falsely increase plasma results.
