Collection Information:

Minimum volume of plasma required is 400 μL for adult samples or 250 μL for pediatric samples.

Reference Ranges:

≤ 76 ng/mL



Test Schedule: Monday - Friday 0800-1600

Comments:

Chromogranin A levels may be elevated in patients treated with proton pump inhibitors. Patients should refrain from taking proton pump inhibitors for at least one week prior to sample collection.

Storage and Shipment:

Store and ship plasma frozen.
