Collect 5cc in a sterile trap. If more than one test is ordered collect >10cc. Remove trap and replace with screw capped lid before transporting.

After hours store at -20°C.

Test Schedule:

Batched twice weekly – Monday/Tuesday and Wednesday/Thursdays routinely

Note:

Samples to be in lab no later than noon Monday and Wednesday to be pretreated for set up the following day.

Special Processing:

Send samples directly to the lab unopened. It is imperative that samples have minimal exposure to air before testing. Store at -20°C after hours.
