4.5 mL Green top	0-2 years: 0.5 mL Green top	
Vacutainer tube	Microtainer	
	2-10 years: 3 mL Green top tube	
Serum from a 5 mL Gold top or 6 mL Red top Vacutainer		
tube is also acceptable.		

Toxic Levels:

Trough: >1.8 mg/L Peak: >10 mg/L

Collection Information:

Collect blood aseptically in a Vacutainer tube.

Minimum volume of serum/plasma required is 1 mL.

Minimum volume of blood required for pediatric sample is 0.5 mL.

Trough specimens are to be drawn immediately before a dose is administered.

Peak specimens should be drawn 30 minutes after an IV injection, 60 minutes after an IM injection, 30 minutes after the end of a 30 minute IV infusion (time frames are longer if the patient is renally compromised).







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Reference Ranges:

Therapeutic	
Trough (Pre-Dose):	Peak (Post Dose):
< = 1.4 mg/L	6-10 mg/L

Interpretive Comments:

To convert from mg/L to umol/L multiply the number by 2.16

Storage and Shipment:

Specimens not tested immediately should be refrigerated as soon as possible and frozen for shipment within 24 hours.
