### **Comments:**

Protein electrophoresis (PEL) is always performed first. The PEL result will determine if IFE is performed. IFE is performed when a possible monoclonal protein band that is quantifiable is detected on PEL that has not been identified previously by IFE. If the band has been identified previously by IFE and the PEL pattern has not changed significantly, the IFE will not be repeated.

IFE uses specific antisera to identify monoclonal immunoglobulins.

### **Storage and Shipment:**

Store and ship serum refrigerated.
