#### Microsporidia – Faeces/Bowel Aspirate

Specimen Type	Collection Information	Collection Device
Faeces Bowel Aspirate	Submit sample in an ova and parasite kit, which consists of two containers. One is for stool and one for stool with preservative. Both containers must be submitted.	

For all other specimens contact the lab before collecting for specific instructions regarding preservation and transport.

## **Storage and Shipment:**

Eosinophilia HIV positive
