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## **Interpretive Comments:**

Clinical history is an important component for diagnostic interpretation.

If there is a clinical suspicion of **lymphoma**, a portion of the first and second pass should be submitted for <u>Flow Cytometry</u> in an appropriate fixative.

## **Critical Information Required:**

An aspiration may be repeated up to 2 additional times. Any further passes after 3 attempts have low diagnostic yields.

#### **Storage and Shipment:**

Specimen container **must be** labelled with patient identification, specimen type and a Cytology fixative label previous to transport.

Transport all specimens in a biohazard transport bag with the specimen in the ziploc area separating the requisition in the side pocket.
