Critical Information Required:

IgG testing will be performed on all Parvovirus Serology requests.

IgG and IgM will <u>only</u> be performed when the following clinical information is provided on the Public Health Laboratory Requisition indicating acute/recent infection:

- Onset Date
- Symptoms

- Indications:
 - acute/recent infection, during pregnancy in suspected cases of hydrops fetalis
 - to assess immune status following exposure to a known active case or during an outbreak investigation
 - investigation of patients with aplastic crisis

Storage and Shipment:

The specimen must be refrigerated. The specimen must be received within 24 hours of collection.
