Ascorbic Acid

#### Specimen:

AdultPediatric4.5 mL Green (Lithium<br/>Heparin) top Vacutainer<br/>tube0-2 years: 0.5 mL Red<br/>Microtainer<br/>2-10 years: 2 mL Red top tubeSerum is also acceptable

### **Collection Information:**

Fasting sample is recommended.

Protect sample from light by wrapping in foil.



Test Schedule: Monday--Friday 0800-1600

Vitamin C results will not be provided on moderately or grossly hemolyzed plasma or serum due to oxidation of vitamin C that occurs with hemolysis.

#### **Reference Ranges:**

≥ 25 µmol/L

#### **Interpretive Comments:**

Vitamin C is very unstable to freeze/thaw cycles. If the specimen is allowed to thaw during processing and shipping, the vitamin C concentration will be very low or undetectable.

#### **Special Processing:**

Protect sample from light, separate then freeze immediately.

Do not allow to thaw.

## Storage and Shipment:

Separate and freeze. Do not allow the specimen to thaw at any time. Any specimen that arrives at the laboratory thawed will not be tested.
