# London Health Sciences Centre reduces surgeries, takes additional steps to manage impact of Omicron variant

(LONDON, Ontario) – Following Provincial directives, effective tomorrow, Jan. 5, 2022 at 12:01 a.m., London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC) will significantly reduce surgeries and diagnostic imaging to include only urgent and emergent cases, as the Omicron variant puts strain on the system, including staffing and resources.

Urgent and emergent appointments or procedures are those services that are required within seven days as determined by the health-care provider.

Additional changes will include:

- Transitioning ambulatory or outpatient appointments from in-person to virtual where appropriate
- Focusing resources on clinics that support hospital diversion or discharge

Any patient whose appointment or procedure is impacted will receive direct communication from their care team. Patients who have not been contacted should come to their scheduled appointment.
