ICE ASSESSMENT

FOR IMMUNE CELL ASSOCIATED NEUROTOXICITY SYNDROME (ICANS)

Orientation

orientation to year, month, city, hospital: 4 points

Naming

Ability to name 3 objects (eg.. point to clock, pen, button): 3 points

Following Commands

Ability to follow simple commands (eg. "Show me 2 fingers" or "Close your eyes and stick out your tongue"): 1 point

Writing

Ability to write a standard sentence (eg. My name is ...): 1 point

Attention

Ability to count backwards from 100 by 10: 1 point

10 points = no impairment; 7-9 = Grade 1; 3-6 = Grade 2; 0-2 = Grade 3; 0 due to patient being unarousable, therefore unable to perform an ICE Assessment = Grade 4. Document in 'Assess/Reassess' field in Vital Signs as 'ICE Score = ___'.
