




# Obstetrical Care, Women's Clinics Move Patient Information

# What is moving?

- ❑ **ALL obstetrical care from St. Joseph's Hospital will be moving to Victoria Hospital, London Health Sciences Centre (LHSC).**
- ❑ Including:
  - ❑ Birthing Centre
  - ❑ Mother Baby Care
  - ❑ Women's Clinics
  - ❑ NICU
  - ❑ Developmental follow up clinic



# When and where?

## ❑ **St. Joseph's Women's Clinic**

- Moving May 31-June 2
- Moving to zone B, level 5, Victoria Hospital

## ❑ **LHSC Women's Clinic**

- Moving May 2
- Moving to zone B, level 5, Victoria Hospital

## ❑ **Birthing Centre, Mother Baby Care, Antenatal and NICU**

- Moving from St. Joseph's Hospital on June 4-5
  - Birthing Centre, Mother Baby Care June 4
  - NICU June 5
- Moving to zones B, C, level 4 of Victoria Hospital



## What if I have an appointment in the Women's Clinic in May or June?

- ❑ The LHSC Women's Clinic moves on May 2
- ❑ The St. Joseph's Women's Clinic moves May 31-June 2
- ❑ We will be confirming the location of your appointment closer to the move date in writing and/or by telephone.
- ❑ If you have an appointment on or around May 2 - June 2, feel free to call the clinic to confirm the location of your appointment in May.
- ❑ The new Women's Clinic will be in zone B, level 5 of Victoria Hospital

# What to do if in labour in June 2011

- ❑ **Moving day for the St. Joseph's birthing centre and mother baby care is **Saturday, June 4.****
- ❑ We will begin admitting patients to the new LHSC unit at noon on June 4.
- ❑ Follow the procedures/precautions as noted in the birthing centre video (available online).
- ❑ Make your way to the birthing centre at **Victoria Hospital, Zone B Entrance, Level 4 (Wellington and Baseline Rd.)**

# How does this impact me?

- ❑ If you are currently registered to give birth at St. Joseph's Hospital and are in labour on or after Saturday, June 4, you will be giving birth at Victoria Hospital. This includes prenatal appointments.
- ❑ If you had already registered to give birth at Victoria Hospital you will still do so but in a brand new space as of May 30 and beyond.
- ❑ LHSC Prenatal and gynecology appointments move to new space on the 5th floor of zone B after May 2.


# Directions to Birthing Centre (Zone B, Level 4)

- ❑ Come to the Baseline Rd. and Wellington Rd. Entrance
- ❑ Enter through the Zone B Main Doors
- ❑ Take Elevators to Level 4 (Birthing Centre)
