





## **Hepatology Application Process:**

The departmental fellowship committee in collaboration with the AFC program committee will handle the advertisement for, selection, and interviewing of Hepatology AFC applicants. The advertisement for a Hepatology position will be dependent on departmental resources and funding. Information regarding the position is readily accessible from the Western University Gastroenterology and Hepatology Website. Moreover, the position will be advertised at the CASL "Canadian Association of Study of Liver" meeting. The AFC program director, as well as the AFC program committee members will participate in the selection and interview process.

Applicants will be required to submit the following documents to the department director:

- 1. Curriculum Vitae
- 2. Three reference letters
- 3. Medical Degree certificate
- 4. Internal Medicine training with Royal College certification or equivalent
- 5. Gastroenterology training with Royal College certification or equivalent

Applications should be submitted directly to program director before September 1st for the next academic year. All files will be reviewed by the AFC Program Committee and candidates will be offered an interview based on career achievements, research, and reference letters. Interview will be conducted in the first two weeks of October each year and successful candidates will be informed by the end of the month.
