## Why has it changed?

- Research has shown that D50W may make glucose management (post-administration) difficult
- Research has shown that reversing hypoglycemia does not require as high a dose as delivered with D50W

## How does it affect paramedic practice?

- If your service only carries D50W, continue to administer D50W do not dilute to create D10W
- If your service carries D10W, administer 2ml/kg to a maximum of 10g (100ml)
- Administer a maximum of 2 doses with a 10 minute interval
