What has changed?

 A new medical directive has been added to the ALS PCS v4.0: Endotracheal and Tracheostomy Suctioning Medical Directive (for both PCPs and ACPs).

Why has it changed?

- There appears to be an increase in prevalence of patients with tracheostomies and stomas requiring assistance/suctioning.
- Clarity and direction was sought for paramedics faced with patients who require endotracheal or tracheostomy suctioning

How does it affect paramedic practice?

 Paramedics are now better able to provide appropriate airway management for patients with tracheostomies or stomas.
