• ETCO₂ has become the standard of care for advanced airway insertion confirmation

Why has it changed? How does it affect paramedic practice?

- ETCO₂ allows for enhanced assessment and management of perfusion in the following patient presentations:
 - o VSA
 - To help identify ROSC
 - To help determine the quality of CPR
 - To help confirm advanced airway placement
 - o DKA
 - o SOB
 - o SIRS
- ETCO₂ is applicable to both ACPs and PCPs with available ETCO₂ equipment
