

Dear SOHO resident,

London Health Sciences Centre has recently awarded a contract to Budget Demolition who will complete the final phase of the decommissioning of the former South Street Hospital buildings. This work involves demolition of the buildings on the north side of South Street, excluding the Health Services Building and former War Memorial Children's Hospital.

You will notice fences being erected around the buildings in the coming days. Decommissioning and demolition are expected to take approximately a year to complete.

During the demolition, we expect that there may be some disruption to the normal flow of traffic around the South St./Colborne St./Hill St. area. There may also be an increase in noise during certain phases of demolition. The health and safety of SOHO residents, and of all Londoners, is a top priority for us and the demolition of these buildings will be planned and monitored carefully.
