RE: Basic Life Support Patient Care Standards, version 3.2

I am pleased to announce the publication and release of the *Basic Life Support Patient Care Standards* (BLS PCS), version 3.2.

Pursuant to clause 11(a) of O. Reg. 257/00 under the *Ambulance Act*, each ambulance service operator and every paramedic shall ensure that patient care is provided in accordance with the *Basic Life Support Patient Care Standards* as published by the Ministry, as that document may be amended from time to time.

Version 3.2 of the BLS PCS represents a "partial update" as per the *Living Document Framework*, and addresses various feedback and recommendations received from system stakeholders. Please refer to the Document Control Matrix of the BLS PCS for further versioning history.

The BLS PCS v3.2 and a summary of changes are enclosed. Note, revisions include specific references throughout the standard regarding Patient Priority Systems (PPSs); additional communications clarifying the process to implement PPSs (including signatories) will follow. Please refer to your Regional Stroke Network with respect to the changes in the Acute Stroke Bypass Protocol (*e.g.* "most appropriate" Designated Stroke Centre).

The BLS PCS v3.2 comes into force as of **September 3, 2019**. Please ensure that your personnel are informed of, and become familiar with the changes and new requirements.

On May 24th, 2019 (13:00-15:00) and June 5th, 2019 (10:00-12:00), the Certification and Patient Care Standards unit will be offering webinars regarding the BLS PCS v3.2. To register, please email ParamedicStandards@ontario.ca.
