

## Big LII, Little LI, ASS (backwards), ALL: Pneumonic help remember STEMI Locations

"The Boot": Elevation in II, III, aVF (Inferior STEMI) patients (with RVI) vitals are typically in their "boots".

"Widow Maker": Elevation in V1 - V4; affects the entire left anterior descending (LAD) artery which is the largest coronary artery of the heart.

Modified 12 Leads: Only with Inferior STEMI

**Reciprocal Changes:** ST Depression on the mirror side of STEMI location = True STEMI

<u>S</u> eptal	Septal Perorating (LAD)	Loss of R wave in V1, V2 or	None

- $\uparrow \underline{A}$ nterior =  $\downarrow$  Inferior Leads
- $\uparrow$  Inferior =  $\downarrow$  Lateral Leads
- ↑ Lateral = ↓ Septal Leads
- $\uparrow \underline{S}$ eptal =  $\lor$  Posterior Leads
