| Pinworm paddle | Place paddle sticky side down using a rocking motion to cover as much of the perianal mucosa as possible. Collect sample first thing in the morning before washing or using toilet. | Pinworm Kit – Contact Microbiology for Pinworm paddle kit |

### **Critical Information Required:**

Ensure the Public Health Laboratory Requisition includes the following:

- If patient has Eosinophilia, HIV, is immunocompromised, has a critical illness or was admitted to ICU, or has a previous parasitic infection
- Indicate Country/Region and if the patient is a new immigrant or refugee or returned traveler under 'Travel' section of the requisition.

Specify **PINWORM** in the Specimen Description field when placing order in PowerChart and on the Public Health Laboratory Requisition.

### **Storage and Shipment:**

The specimen must be stored at room temperature.

The specimen must be received within 24 hours of collection.
